

LISTS OF RABBIT BREEDERS AVAILABLE

A list of breeders of Chinchilla rabbits, one of breeders of other utility rabbits, and one of breeders of fancy rabbits have been compiled by the Biological Survey and are ready for free distribution to inquirers who may wish to communicate with rabbit breeders in different parts of the country or to purchase stock. The combined lists contain about 4,000 names arranged alphabetically by State, with symbol letters opposite each name indicating the kinds of rabbits kept. Copies of the lists may be obtained upon request to the Biological Survey, United States Department of Agriculture, Washington, D. C.

Beaver Trap Patented

A patent (No. 1576707) has been granted on a beaver trap invented by Vernon Bailey, of the Biological Survey of the United States Department of Agriculture, for capturing beavers alive for propagation and restocking purposes. The trap is not designed for taking these animals for their fur. The patent indicates this new and useful improvement in animal traps to the people of the United States and allows its manufacture by anyone for private or commercial purposes.
