**OPEN SEASON FOR WOODCOCK  
IN NEW HAMPSHIRE CHANGED**

Woodcock may be hunted from October 1 to October 31, inclusive, in New Hampshire during the coming fall as the result of a recent change in the regulations under the migratory-bird treaty act, as announced by the Biological Survey of the United States Department of Agriculture, which administers this law. The open season on the woodcock in the New England States under the Federal regulations will therefore be from October 1 to October 31, inclusive, in Maine, New Hampshire, and Vermont, and from October 20 to November 19, inclusive, in Massachusetts, Rhode Island, and Connecticut.
