NEW SUPERINTENDENT OF BEAR  
RIVER BIRD REFUGE APPOINTED

George E. Mushbach game protector of the Biological

Survey of the United States Department of Agriculture, has been appointed superintendent of the Bear River Migratory Bird Refuge, Utah. The appointment took effect on September 16, and will fill the position made vacant by the recent resignation of David H. Madsen to enter the National Park Service. Mr Mushbach has been connected with the Biological Survey as United States game protector since November, 1919, with headquarters at Billings, Mont., prior to which he was on the force of the Montana State Fish and Game Commission, and has long been interested in game-conservation work. During his service as a game protector he was on numerous occasions assigned to difficult investigations in connection with bird refuges and big-game preserves, and gained a wide knowledge of bird and mammal life. His headquarters will be Ogden, Utah.
