STAMP COLLECTORS CAN  
STILL BUY DUCK STAMPS

Philatelists interested in building up a collection of migratory waterfowl hunting stamps can still obtain the 1934 stamp at post offices in county seats and in cities with a population of 2,500 or over, according to an announcement of the U. S. Biological Survey. The 1934 stamp will be withdrawn from sale after June 30.

The stamp, says the Bureau, is also available to individuals desiring to aid in the migratory waterfowl restoration program. It may be purchased singly in unlimited quantities but under existing law cannot be sold in blocks.
