FISHERY FILM CHOSEN FOR INTERNATIONAL DISPLAY

Albert M. Day, Director of the Fish and Wildlife Service, announced today that the educational motion picture film Filleting and Packaging Fish, recently completed by the Service's Commercial Fisheries Division, had been selected by a Department of State Review Committee for competitive display at the VIII International Exhibition of Cinematographic Art which opens in Venice, Italy, August 23, 1947.

This film is in two parts: Part I is a general orientation picture showing the typical methods employed commercially in the processing and freezing of packaged fish for market; Part II is a skill teaching film showing how both flat and round fish are filleted.

The film has already been shipped to the American Embassy in Rome for entry in the competition.
