PROGRESSIVE FISH CULTURIST AVAILABLE FOR ANOTHER THREE YEAR-PERIOD

The Fish and Wildlife Service of the Department of the Interior has been granted Budget Bureau permission to continue publication of the Progressive Fish Culturist for another three years, Assistant Secretary Ross L. Leffler said today.

Since the first issue in 1934, sport fishery technicians in all parts of the country have been kept abreast of developments in the fish culture field through this medium.

The quarterly publication is devoted to the development and preservation of the Nation's \$2 billion-a-year sport fishery through presentation of the latest findings of fishery scientists and practical workers. Biologists, administrators, technicians and practical fish culturists, are among the contributors.

A practical medium for the interchange of ideas relating to the various technical and scientific problems of the country's sport fishery, its material is by--and primarily for--those engaged in this work. Its topics touch every problem phase of the fish hatching, rearing, and stocking program.
