RADIO SPOTS FOR DUCK CONSERVATION CAMPAIGN

Hunters! There's a poor duck crop this fall. You can help them come back. Shoot only drakes. Spare the hens to nest next year.

Hunters! Let the ducks come in close so you can identify them. Then try to shoot only the drakes. This will spare hens to nest next year.

Duck Hunters! Did you know drakes usually outnumber the hens? If you shoot only drakes this fall, you'll save hens to nest next year. This is one way you can help the ducks come back. They've been hit hard by drought on the nesting grounds.

Hunters! The plumage of most male ducks is very different from that of the females. Learn to identify and shoot only drakes. This will spare the hens to nest next year and help bring back the ducks.

Duck Hunters! Bag limits are low this fall. Prolong your hunt by shooting only drakes. This also will save female ducks to nest next year.
