INTERIOR AREA REDEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES PUSH AHEAD

Increased activity in meeting its responsibilities under the Administration's area Redevelopment Program was reported today by the Department of the Interior, as the Fish and Wildlife Service's Bureau of Commercial Fisheries announced new operational plans for its area redevelopment functions.

Proposed area redevelopment projects and loan applications in the commercial fisheries field referred to the Department for review by the Area Redevelopment Administration will be coordinated by Leslie D. McMullin, who has been appointed IRA program liaison officer for the Bureau of Commercial Fisheries in Washington, D. C. In addition, he will cooperate with Bureau field personnel in assisting fishing industry firms located in redevelopment areas to formulate redevelopment plans and make appropriate applications for Federal aid.
