## SECOND WILDLIFE PORTRAIT SERIES NOW AVAILABLE

The Department of the Interior's Fish and Wildlife Service announced today that Wildlife Portrait Series No. 2, featuring color reproductions of 10 original fish paintings by its artist Bob Hines, is now available from the Government Printing Office.

The paintings, which feature such popular sport fish as largemouth bass, channel catfish, and trout in their native surroundings, measure 17" x 14" with a white border ready for framing. They were first reproduced in the Service's new book Sport Fishing U.S.A.

The set is available for \$2.50 from the Superintendent of Documents, U.S. Government Printing Office, Washington, D.C. 20402.

Wildlife Portrait Series No. 1 remains available from the Superintendent of Documents for \$2.00. The first series consists of 10 color photographs of native American wildlife species.
