ANNUAL MEETING OF WATERFOWL ADVISORY COUNCIL

The annual meeting of the Waterfowl Advisory Council will be held on August 5, 1975, in Washington, D.C.

The Council will review the staff recommendations of the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service for 1975-76 waterfowl regulations, and present its recommendations to the Director of the Fish and Wildlife Service for 1975-76 waterfowl season "frameworks"--season and bag limits within which the States can fix their individual regulations.

The meeting will take place at 9 a.m. in the Conference Room 2008, New Executive Office Building, 726 Jackson Place, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20006.

Comments of interested persons are invited and must be filed in writing with the Director before or after the meeting.
