ANNUAL HUNTING REGULATIONS
CONFERENCE SET FOR JUNE 22

The annual regulations conference on migratory shore and upland game bird hunting will take place on June 22, 1976.

The purpose of the meeting of State and Federal wildlife officials plus the public is to review the status of mourning doves, woodcock, band-tailed pigeons, white-winged doves, rails, gallinules, and common snipe. Further, the hunting regulations for next autumn's season will be discussed.

The public is invited to attend. Persons wishing to attend should notify the Director, U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, Washington, D.C. 20240, in advance.

The conference will be held in Room 2008, New Executive Office Building, 726 Jackson Place, N.W., Washington, D.C., at 9 a.m.

To the extent that time permits, the chairman of the meeting will accept brief oral statements from the public at the close of the committee's agenda, provided such statements are also submitted in writing.
